

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Peoples Health Employee Accidental Death & Dismemberment

This is a summary of the annual report of the Peoples Health Employee Accidental Death & Dismemberment, EIN 72-1267232, Plan No. 507, for period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has a contract with Standard Insurance Company to pay all claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2015 were \$14,234.

Because it is a so called "experience-rated" contract, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2015, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contract were \$14,234 and the total of all benefit claims paid under the contract during the plan year was \$15,181.
